FREDINA'S STORY

Two year-old Fredina has eye cancer. When we met her in 2025 she was in extreme pain and suffering severe inflammation. The outlook was not good.

We stepped in, contributing to the costs of tests, scans, medication and chemotherapy. Fredina's eye is no longer swollen - though she will probably never see again - and we pray her upcoming operation will get rid of the cancer for good. All this has cost around £300.

AARON AND EVANS' STORIES



Aaron (top) is 8, despite his tiny frame. He has hydrocephalus and almost died due to malnutrition. We provided a life-saving food package (above left), as well as other support such as a mattress and radio. Evans (above) was also dangerously malnourished. Since our intervention, he has put on weight and even begun to walk (above right).

A typical high nutrient food package includes rice, oil, beans, tomatoes, fish etc and costs about £50.
